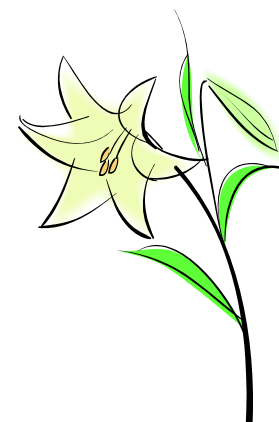

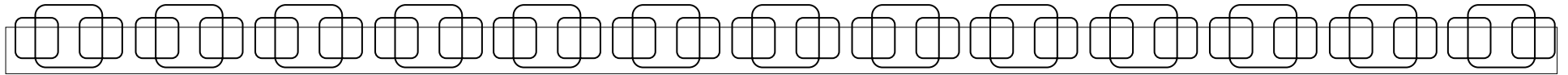

This workshop will provide information about grief and healing, realistic grief and mourning expectations and normal grief reactions. It will also identify the factors that affect the intensity of grief and how our own personal experiences have impacted them. This will allow those in the helping field gain the knowledge necessary to help their clients move through the grief process so that they can find healing and hope once again in their lives.
