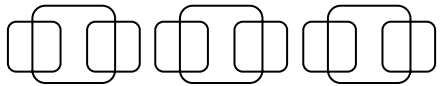

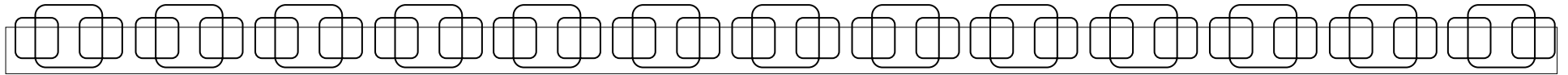

Purpose

Those struggling with addiction face many challenges, and as a result of their addiction put themselves in high-risk situations. Sexual behavior is just one of these risky situations. This workshop is designed to provide you with the most current information on HIV/AIDS and other STD's, which greatly affect this population of individuals. It will also explore the connection between alcohol/drug use and the contraction of HIV or other STD's. Participants will have the honor of hearing not only from an expert in this field but from individuals who live with HIV/AIDS every day.

Objectives

At the completion of this workshop participants will be able to:

- ◆ Identify facts about HIV/AIDS and STD's.
- ◆ Identify how STD's, including HIV are transmitted.
- ◆ Identify the risk factors for developing an HIV infection as a result of engaging in high risk behavior.
- ◆ Recognize the day-to-day challenges of living with HIV.
- ◆ Understand the connection between alcohol/drug use and sexual behavior, and how that puts individuals at risk.

She has been in the addiction field for over 15 years specializing in the prevention of this disease.
